

Statement on the Collection and Utilization of Personal Data by the National Taiwan Library

The National Taiwan Library (hereinafter referred to as the library) provides services in accordance with the Library Act. In accordance with the provisions of Article 8 of the Personal Data Protection Act, the following matters are announced.

一、 Purpose of Collecting Personal Data

The library must obtain your personal data for the purpose of performing online applications of library passes, offering usage of the library resources, handling promotion activities, and other services.

二、 Types of Collected Personal Data

The personal data provided by readers such as the name, date of birth, e-mail address, occupation, household registration and mailing address, contact phone number, and national identification card will be properly kept and maintained by the library. The data will only be used for service-related identification, registration of learning certifications, statistical analysis of the library's services, and the necessary notification and contacting for implementing various services.

三、 Duration, Region, Subject, and Method for Using Personal Data

The personal data will only be used by the library in the territories of the Republic of China within the scope necessary for the aforementioned collection purposes, and the personal data will be used in a reasonable manner until the collection purpose no longer exists.

四、 Provision of Personal Data

1. Individuals are free to choose if they want to provide their personal data to the library. However, not providing personal data or requesting to delete or suspend processing or usage of personal data and having the library approve the request will result in the library being unable to conduct the necessary review and processing operations for the provision of various services.

2. Individuals are requested to provide their correct and complete personal data, and any changes to the personal data should be proactively reported for correction to the library. The library will not be liable for related compensation if individuals provide personal data that is incorrect, outdated, incomplete, or misleading, resulting in damage to individuals' relevant rights and interests.

五、 Confidentiality of Personal Data

The library will do its best to protect personal data. Should the personal data be stolen, leaked, altered, or otherwise infringed upon due to natural disasters, incidents, or force majeure, the library will notify individuals by phone, e-mail, or website announcements after the investigation has been completed.

六、 Rights that the Party Involved May Exercise in Relation to Personal Data

Individuals can exercise the following rights with regards to the personal data provided in accordance with Article 3 of the "Personal Data Protection Act": (1) Inquiry or request for viewing. (2) Request to make copies. (3) Request for supplementation or correction. (4) Request to suspend collection, processing, or utilization. (5) Request for deletion.

However, the library may not grant the request if it is necessary for the library to carry out its services.

- 七、 The library may provide personal data and relevant information in accordance with laws and regulations, or to comply with the requirements of the competent authorities and judiciaries in accordance with the law.
